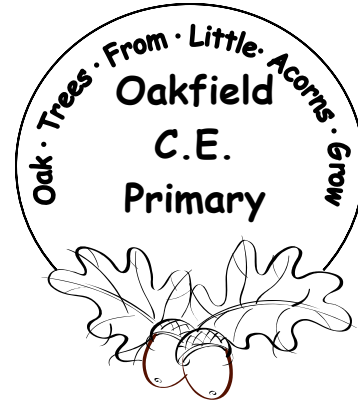

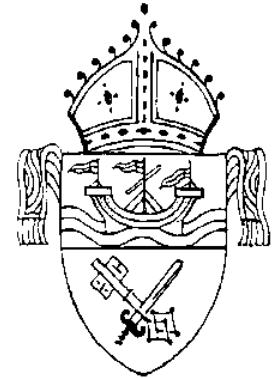
Mission Statement
